Responding to Small Fuel Spills from Vessels in Marinas

(Gas, diesel or lubricant)

WHAT TO DO FIRST

- Stop the release, if safe to do so
- · Remove all people and sources of spark
- Determine the product that was spilled if-gasoline, contact local fire department
- Deploy equipment if appropriate and available
 - -- DO NOT APPLY DETERGENTS
 - -- DO NOT contain or boom GASOLINE unless deemed safe*
- Contact authorities as soon as possible (see reverse for numbers)
- *Containing gasoline may create an explosive atmosphere.
 Air monitoring may be required to determine safety.

INFORMATION for the REPORT

- Source of the pollution and owners name.
- · Location of spill incident.
- What is the product, and how much is spilled.
- Measures being taken

to stop release

to cleanup spilled product, if possible

Any injuries or safety concerns.
